The tradition of waving Palms

In the Holy Land vast farms of date palms grow. These trees grow tall – up to 100 feet high. It was from these that Jesus' followers would have taken branches to wave as a way of showing they recognised him as king. In other cultures, palms were a sign of victory.

In the book of Revelations, John sees a huge number, impossible to count, of people from every nation dressed in white and standing before the throne of the lamb. They are holding palms in their hands Rev 7:9. So palms became a Christian symbol of witness and even martyrdom.

Why not take an extra palm cross to give to a friend? It's a simple way of evangelising and of 'bearing witness'.
