## Ideas for questions:

- Which vinegar causes the best eruption?
- How does an aeroplane stay up in the sky?
- Which liquids can flowers live in for the longest?
- Which leaves fall the guickest?
- How much sugar is in your drinks?
- Can you make a floating marshmallow sink?
- What different sounds can elastic bands make?
- How can we sort leaves?
- Which sport makes my heart beat the fastest?
- How is the pitch of a wind instrument affected by it's length?
- What happens to refrigerated food when we leave it out?
- Can you light a light bulb without a battery?
