Dear Parents / Carers,

I am writing to confirm the details for instrumental lessons in the Summer Term 2018. The details below remind you of the day that the lessons take place so that you can ensure that your child brings their instrument and music to school, please. Please note the additional / changed lessons which are highlighted.

We work on a 30 lesson year, which means that the children will have an average of 10 lessons per term. As I outlined before, the lessons provided by Dorset Music Service follow a strict timetable of dates (drums/ keyboard/violin) and the other instrumental teaching is supplied by private teachers which allows for a little more flexibility. All children receive the same number of lessons across the year. (Please note that I am trying to re-schedule the keyboard lesson missed due to the INSET day recently).

Timetables can be found on the Music Room notice board for children to look at. Dates can be found below for your reference. Please note that it is sometime necessary to change or cancel tuition at short notice. Lessons will be re-arranged where possible or refunded. Advance notice will be given where possible.
