FOLLOWING ON FROM DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

ST. FAUSTINA KOWALSKA (b. 25/08/05, d. 5/10/38)

Maria Faustina Kowalska was born on 25. August 1905 in Glogowiec, Poland – the 3rd of ten children. Aged 19 having a vision of a suffering Jesus, she immediately packed a bag and took the train to Warsaw, went into the first church she saw (St. James') and attended Mass. She visited several convents in Warsaw and entered the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy and was professed on 30. April 1928, aged 20 taking the name Faustina – “fortunate or blessed one.” She wrote that on the night of 22. February (1931) Jesus appeared wearing a white garment and rays of light radiating from his heart. She wrote that Jesus told her “Paint and image according to the pattern you see, with the signature – “Jesus, I trust in you.” I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel and then throughout the world. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish.” Three years later the first artistic rendering of the image of Jesus was completed and Faustina wrote in her diary that Jesus wanted this Image to be ‘solemnly blessed on the First Sunday after Easter, which was to be the ‘Feast of Mercy’ and is celebrated throughout the Christian World. On 13 September 1935 she wrote of a vision about the Chaplet of Divine Mercy which is about a third of the length of the Rosary. Faustina wrote about the Chaplet's prayers – ‘to obtain mercy, to trust in Christ's mercy and to show mercy to others.’
