Last year you were all introduced to our PSHE scheme called 'Jigsaw' and you were invited to attend a meeting. This year we are sending a reminder of what is going to be covered in the unit 'Changing Me'.

In Year Six, there are four lessons that fall into the Sex and Relationship theme.

Lesson	What is being taught	When taught
Lesson 2	Explain how girl's and boy's bodies change as they get older and understand the importance of looking after themselves physically and emotionally.	Thurs18 th June
Body changes	Express how they feel about the changes that happen.	
Lesson 3	Ask questions that need answered about changes as they grow older.	Weds 25 th June
Girl Talk/Boy Talk	Reflect on how they feel about asking questions and about the answers received.	
Lesson 4	Describe how a baby develops from birth through the nine months of pregnancy.	Thurs 9 th July
Babies	Recognise how they feel when they reflect on the development and birth of a baby.	
Lesson 5	Understand how being physically attracted to someone changes the nature of the relationship.	Weds 15 th July
Attraction	Totalionomp.	
	Express how they feel about the growing independence of becoming a teenager and how confident they are that they can cope with this.
