Our Purpose

The Children's Mind Foundation* was established in late 2024 to support neurodivergent kids by: Building their first friendships in life-through after school clubs that focus on young children having the opportunity to play, learn.

There are Support group for their care givers; Improve diagnosis time for children from disadvantaged backgrounds.

Research shows that half of Autistic people and those with ADHD will experience one or more mental health conditions at some point in their life; these may include depression or anxiety disorders (can lead towards suicide attempts).

The foundation believes that early support and intervention for children and their primary care givers will improve their lives significantly.

The Foundation has created a dedicated photoshoot session for the two sisters who have neurodivergent needs.

In February 2025 we spent a day at the beautiful Upton County Park.

This was to celebrate the birthday of the younger sister; whose enjoyment was increased by the presence of her older sister.

This was a unique opportunity for the Foundation to work in partnership with a nationally renowned photographer, who is also ADHD and Autistic.

It is crucial that care givers of the neurodivergent kids understand and learn from life experiences shared by adults diagnosed later in the life.



Our Kids

In partnership and the support of Discovery Village, local children's play, Foundation run a play session in late February 2025 for 7 local children with and without neurodivergent needs.

The children will have the opportunity to learn about various professions for example firefighter, post person, vet and hairdresser. This is undertaken in a playful and safe environment, and will form the very first friendships in their life outside of their normal circle.

The session created networking opportunities for parents, to exchange experiences, support each other, and give even better ideas what support

Foundation can provide to them.

This was our first community benefit.
