### **Music with Myleene Klass on YouTube**

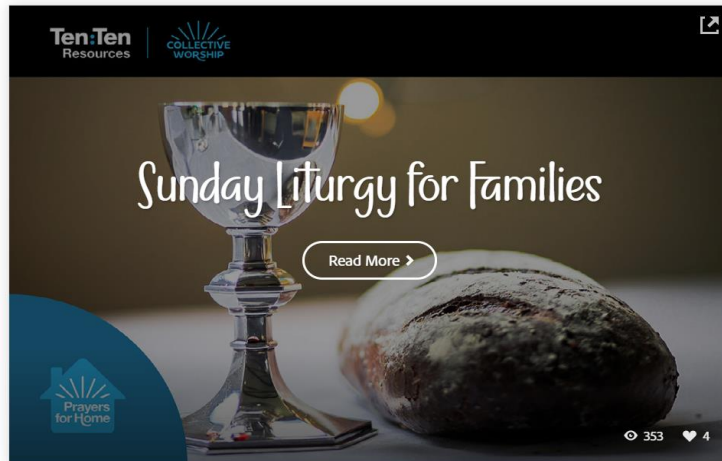
Twice a week. Next one Friday 27 March 10am, but can view any time.

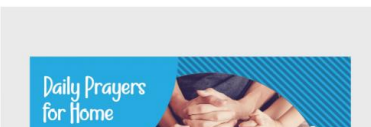

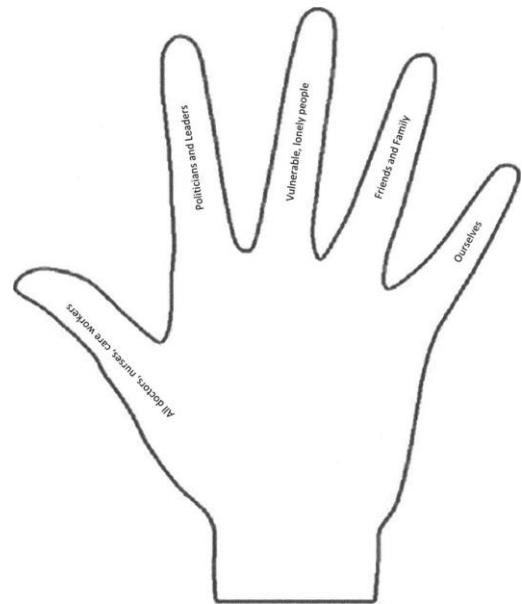
**A prayer remembering God is with us:**
