**RE**: This week we have explored the important role of angels and the messages they conveyed during the Christmas story. We have looked at messages that need to be transmitted in our world today and designed short speeches to present to the class. Next week we will start work on our new topic, Revelations.

**Maths:** This week the children have been multiplying and dividing by 1 and 0. They have multiplied one and two digit numbers and will progress onto multiplying three numbers. Next week we will be moving on to multiplying numbers with multiples of 10 and multiplying 2 digit numbers.

Thank you to the parents who spotted the mistakes we made last week, we apologise for not proof reading our work accurately and hopefully there are less (or none) today. Interestingly, the focus of Wednesday afternoon was how to develop ways of increasing a 'Growth Mindset' through Resilience, Relationships, Resourcefulness and Reflection.

Statutory Year 4 times table test - please help your child to be prepared.

**Literacy**: This week we have started the class book 'Varjak Paw' by S.F. Said. We have made predictions and suggestions about how the story will develop. The children have written their first suspense story of year 4 using all their literacy skills. One lesson saw the dramatized of an important incident involving the main character followed by arguments for and against a critical decision. Next week we will explore the description in the text from the character's point of views and Varjak's feelings after the tragic events of chapter 5.
