This week we are continuing with our Phase 3 sounds. We have looked at 'y' and 'z' and will move on to look at our digraph sounds 'qu' and 'ch' later in the week. We have had lots of fun learning the actions for 'y' and 'z', which I'm sure the children would love to share with you.

Maths

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In our maths over the next few weeks we will be looking at the numbers 6 -10. This week we have begun with the number 6 looking at the ways which 6 can be expressed. We have made piles of 6, found the number 6 on a dice and with Numicon, and thought about the ways we can write 6.

What we've been doing

This week in our PE lesson we have been using the apparatus in the hall, exploring ways of travelling and climbing. This was lots of fun! Following on from our work on hot and cold places, we are exploring what happens to ice when it is left in a warm environment, and how we might go about freezing water. We will also be practising our folding and cutting skills by making snowflakes.
