Dear Parents and Carers

This week

Literacy: The children will continue focusing on a new story- `How to wash a woolly mammoth`. This is an instructional text and we will be looking at sentence openers, such as `first, next, after that and finally`. You could enhance your child's learning through looking and following different instructions, for example baking cakes. The children will be performing the story and drawing story maps.

Mathematics: The focus this week will be subtracting within 20. The children have been learning how to count back from 20. For example, 18-6, and 16-8. It would be beneficial if you could practise subtracting at home. They will be reviewing addition and subtraction within 20.

They will need to learn how to spell numbers in words.

They will focus on arithmetic skills.

RE: We are looking at different ways that we can play, such as through dance and singing. Next week the children will be exploring how Jesus wants us to be close to Him, through their behaviour and drama.

Topic: We will be learning about fossils and Mary Anning.
