Next week we will be holding our first 'School Mass' for a long time. We will be celebrating 'Harvest'. Please can we ask that your child brings in a donation to school on either Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday. We will use these to make a display in church on Friday and then we will be taking all the donations to the local food bank.

The Food Bank is always grateful for what we, and the other churches in Poole, provide. Some items such as tinned fish, pasta, long life milk and long life fruit juice are particularly welcome. Food should ideally have a shelf-life of 6 months and tins with ring-pulls are very useful. Here is a list of items which the Food Bank always needs:
