Adoremus – Eucharistic Congress 7th - 9th September 2018

Our first ever national Eucharistic Congress takes place this weekend in Liverpool. The theme is adoration of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist.

10,000 people from England and Wales are expected to attend, including 124 candidates attending from our diocese including Bishop Mark and five priests.

Six people (including Deacon Nick) are travelling up from St Mary's and St Anthony's.

Friday is a symposium of talks.

Saturday is the main Congress day: the keynote speaker will be Bishop Robert Baron.

Sunday is mass at Liverpool Cathedral followed by a procession of the Blessed Sacrament through the streets of Liverpool.

Adoremus 2018 is a unique opportunity for the Church to gather and reflect on the centrality of the Eucharist and particularly to explore the place of Eucharistic Adoration.

Aims

In the Praise and Witness to the Eucharistic Lord, the aims of Adoremus that can be adopted locally are:

- To rejuvenate Eucharistic Adoration in Parishes
- To encourage greater love for the mystery of the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar

- To engender a deeper understanding of the place of the Eucharist in the life of the church
- To provide practical resources for Eucharistic Adoration for Parishes and Schools
- To better form Extraordinary Ministers
- To better equip Parish catechists and Schools
- To confirm Parish ministry around the centrality of the Eucharist

We are joining our prayers with those attending the Congress by holding 3 Holy Hours over the weekend (see the front of the newsletter for times). Adoration of the Eucharist deepens our relationship with Christ, it enables us to be more effective disciples who will be better able to lead others to the life of the Church that has the Eucharist at its heart.
