This week has begun with an email from one of our school neighbours.

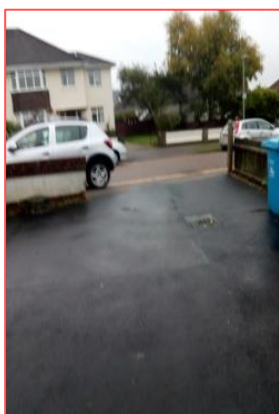
