Following the government announcement last Sunday schools will re-open for Foundation, Year 1 and Year 6, as well as key worker and vulnerable children. We have sent out a form asking parents of these children to let us know if they would like to take up the offer in order to help us plan the way ahead.

This week we have been measuring rooms, removing furniture to calculate how many children could safely be introduced back into school. We have also been working with staff to ensure their safety and finding out who can return to school to support our offer. Class sizes will have to be reduced to between 10 and 15 children. There is much to do to ensure the safety of all children and staff and thank you for the continued lovely messages telling us to take care and thanking us for all we are doing, really showing us that you are keeping us in your prayers. Thank you.

This weekend will be spent completing the "CAST return to school planning document" and hopefully after that we will have a clearer picture of where the classes will be in school, how big they will be and who will be taking them. Thank you for your patience and understanding.




Every week I find things in the google classroom which are really fantastic. Keep up the hard work everyone.
