## We are coming to ST Mary's school

We are two practising ceramic artists with over 20 years experience between us, During this time we had worked predominantly with adults and children with additional needs. We founded The Clayshack four years ago after finding out that very few primary schools had ceramics on their curriculum anymore. This was due to government funding and cuts. Schools having to spend the little funds they had on much more academic subjects. We felt that children were missing out on being creative and being able to express this part of their character.

Our flagship school is Longfleet primary school based in Poole. We started doing one afterschool club 1 day a week. Due to the popularity and demand for the club we quickly grew to three days a week and every half term is full to its capacity. Many of the children in the groups have been with us up to three years. We have children coming back to see us after high school because they miss it so much. We feel this in itself proves the love for the arts and our club within the primary school setting.

We have found that clay is a wonderful medium for many children, allowing them to relax and forget about their worries and the pressures of every day .Many children would not touch clay in their lifetime due to the arts being cut in schools. We felt this very sad, as we know firsthand how wonderful clay can be. At The Clayshack we believe that all children should be given the opportunity to express themselves creatively and have some fun.

In our classes we encourage that creativity. We ask the children what they would like to make and help them build and achieve their ideas. We teach many different aspects of hand building and sculpting. Team building set pieces as a group. We use fine earthenware and terracotta clay. We teach the children all about the drying and firing process and what the kiln does. The children love getting messy and squidging the clay. They love the group chats about what we are going to make next and how we are going to make it.

We run weekly competitions for builder of the week and table of the week. The winner receives a medal to keep and a sweet. This causes a lot of excitement within the groups.

We hope that every child that comes through our doors will have a clay masterpiece to cherish with memories that last long into their adulthood. We very much look forward to meeting your children.

If your child is successful, we will then contact you via text message. All other names will be placed onto our waiting list for the next half term.

All aprons, materials and tools are provided.
