Revision worksheets on angles, fractions and mixed operations.

Our learning this week:

English – We will complete our comparative report on Athens and Sparta and begin learning about the Battle of Marathon in preparation for a letter from the battle field. We will focus on the use of a colon between two clauses and look at the progressive tense

Reading: This week we will look at another chapter in The Adventures of Odysseus by Hugh Lupton, focusing on skimming and scanning, authorial choice and the use of evidence from the text. We will also complete a reading assessment.

Maths – We will continue our work on multiplying fractions as well as completing a series of Maths assessments.

History/Geography: In history we will continue with our unit of Ancient Greece focusing on historical primary and secondary sources.

Dance/Drama: We will be continuing to create a dance and drama piece linked to our class novel The Adventure of Odysseus.

RE : Next week in R.E. we will be exploring St. Paul's importance in the history of the Church.
