#### Literacy

## Reading:

Please sign your child's diary 3 times per week. We will collect diaries in each Tuesday to check this. Your child will receive a house point if they have three signatures for the week. Please ensure your child has their reading book and diary in school every day.

In Guided Reading lessons the focus this half term will continue to be broadening an understanding of vocabulary. The children are continuing to investigate meanings of words and answering questions about the authors choices of language in our exciting text: 'Escape from Pompeii.'

Speech marks.

During our spelling and grammar lessons, we have been doing spelling practise using new strategies. We are revisiting how to use speech marks correctly and revising grammar rules for using 'a' and 'an'.

They have planned a scene from the text in their own version and next week they will be writing up their Pompeii story that they have planned. We will be focusing on improving/self and peer editing.

# **Mathematics**

We started our angles unit of work this week and we have been recognising angles as a description of a turn and angles in shapes. The children have begun to learn about right angles, acute and obtuse angles. The children will be carrying out investigative work on angles next week.

If your child needs some extra help with their homework please could they inform us before Tuesday, so that they have the opportunity to mark the homework together.

## <u>RE</u>

In RE next week the children will be retelling the story of Saul. They will be using drama, artwork and written work to retell this story.

# **Science**

This week we will studied the life cycle of a plant, using drama, research and diagrams. Next week we will complete this task and then begin our 'Light' topic. We will be researching light sources in and around the school and begin to look at shadows, when the sun comes out.

#### <u>History</u>

We have been finding out about different aspects of Roman life. Next week we will continue learning basic facts about Romans, with a focus on how the Roman Empire has affected Britain.
