## <u>PARISH REGISTRATION - St Mary's and St Anthony's</u>

St Mary's and St Anthony's parishes are trialling a new Parish on line Database for the Diocese. Even if you filled in a 'Keeping in Touch' form last year, we would be grateful if you could take some time to go the parish website (both www.stmaryspoole.org.uk and www.stanthonys-broadstone.co.uk will take you to the joint St Mary's and St Anthony's website) and use the link under 'Register' and register yourselves. (Each adult must do this individually). The reason for this is the new Data Protection laws which came in last year meant we could not keep all the information we previously held about our parishioners - date of reception of sacraments, names of children, etc. We can only put on the database the basic information you provided on the keeping in touch form. So for some parishioners we don't even have the basic information of if you are married, have children or where you live. Not having this information does hamper Father getting to know everybody in your family. If you do not have access to the internet please contact your parish office.
