to know what you thought about it. Please let us know whether you think we should do this again in future.


Congratulations to Blue House 'Lulworth' who won the cup this year. Chloe in Year 6 collected it on behalf of all the children.

Look at all the books that Mrs Eddy has won for the library through entering a competition.




Well done Nikodem for achieving third place with his team during the Festival of Polish Poetry "Wierszowisko 2019" in London on 9th of June 2019.
