Dear Parents / Carers,

I am writing to confirm the details for the instrumental lessons for Spring Term 2019. The details below outline the day that the lessons take place so that you can ensure that your child brings their instrument and music to school, please.

We work on a 30 lesson year, which means that the children will have an average of 10 lessons per term. As all of our instrumental teaching is now supplied by private teachers, this allows for a little more flexibility so that busy weeks such as KS2 SATs week can be avoided for tuition.

Timetables can be found on the Music Room notice board for children to look at and our teachers are proactive in finding children who forget to turn up at the correct time. Dates can be found below for your reference. Please note that it is sometimes necessary to change or cancel tuition at short notice. Lessons will be re-arranged where possible or refunded.
