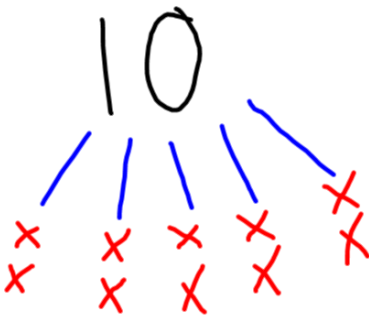
Next Week:

Literacy: We will be looking at poetry. We will be looking at poetic language and devises before writing our own polar bear poems.

Maths: In maths we will be continuing our topic of division. We teach the children to divide by using a sharing shower, dividing by 2's, 5's and 10's. We will be also linking division to multiplication.

For example:

$$10 \div 5 =$$



We have 10 to share between 5, so we draw 5 strands. Then we share the 10 out between the 5 strands to find the answer of 2.

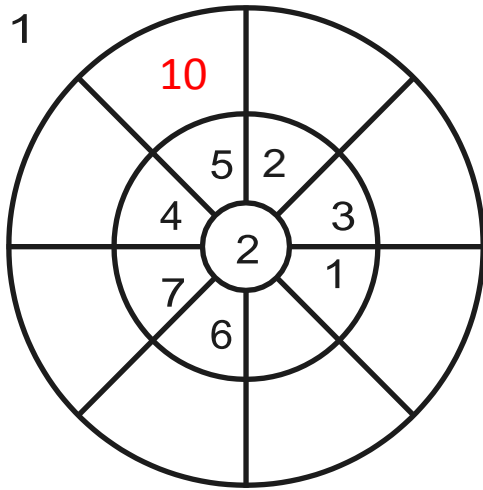
RE: We will be starting our topic of Advent. We will be looking at the Advent Wreath and the foretelling of Jesus' arrival in Isaiah.

Homework:

Spelling tests will continue to be on a Thursday.

Maths – Multiplication wheels. The number in the centre is what you multiply by, so here it is multiplied by 2. The numbers in the middle are what you multiply the centre number by. The outer ring is where you write the answer. For example, $2 \times 5 = 10$.
