Barclays House Choir and St Peter's Orchestra promise you an exhilarating musical evening with their performance of the Mozart Requiem & Operatic Classics.

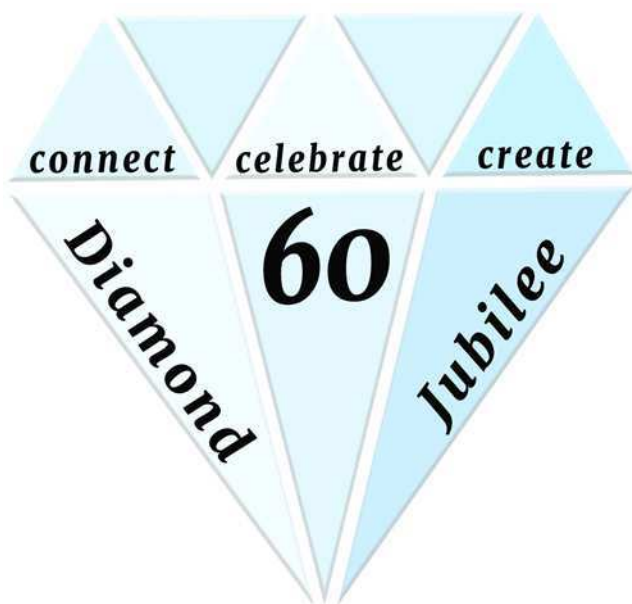
