Dear Parents and Carers,

You will also be aware that the number of positive cases in BCP are rising rapidly and last week they doubled from the week before. The impact in school is that we have more children self-isolating due to being in close contact with a positive case. We continue to pray that we manage to avoid positive cases in school but if we do we will follow the required procedures.
